ORDINANCE NO. 20, 2003

ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BICYCLES, MOPEDS AND MOTORCYCLES

EFFECTIVE JUNE 11, 2003

Section 1. Rules for bicycles, moped and motorcycles:

- (A) A person operating a bicycle, moped or motorcycle shall not ride other than upon the pavement and regular seat attached thereto, nor carry any other person upon such bicycle, moped or motorcycle other than upon a firmly attached and regular seat thereon, nor shall any person ride upon a bicycle, moped or motorcycle other than upon such a firmly attached and regular seat.
- (B) A person shall ride upon a motorcycle only while sitting astride the seat, facing forward, with one leg on each side of the motorcycle.
- (C) No person operating a bicycle shall carry any package, bundle, or article that prevents the driver from keeping at least one hand upon the handle bars.
- (D) No bicycle, moped or motorcycle shall be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed and equipped, nor shall any moped or motorcycle be operated on a highway when the handle bars or grips are more than 15 inches higher than the seat or saddle for the operator.
- (E) No bicycle, moped or motorcycle shall be operated on the sidewalks of the Village of Cleves by any person 13 years of age or older.
